- Styrofoam** (Clean & Dry - remove labels & tape)
- Household Batteries** (no leaking or broken; tape ends)
- Fluorescent tubes and bulbs** (no broken bulbs; limit 4 ft)
- Small Electronics** (TVs, computers, etc.)
- Small Appliances** (non-Freon)
- Clothing & linens** (any condition, must be clean & dry)
- Furniture & household goods** (good condition - for reuse)
- Paper for shredding** (limit 4 boxes)
